## Financial Aid Instructions

1. Apply for admission to ACC. Be sure to include your Social Security number.
2. All students interested in being considered for financial aid must file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The FAFSA form is available online at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). Authorize electronic release of the results (called the Student Aid Report or SAR) to ACC by writing our code

number, 002237, in the appropriate space on the FAFSA. If you have already filed and did not list ACC to receive your SAR, please call (989) 358-7205.

3. If you are applying for an academic scholarship or other types of general scholarships (as listed in the college catalog), you must file a Free Application for Federal Student Aid and an ACC Scholarship Application Form, available at area high schools and from the Financial Aid Office, Alpena Community College. Both forms are available beginning in late January for the following academic year.
4. All applicants are eligible to be considered for federal, state, and institutional programs.
