ALPENA COMMUNITY COLLEGE AND ACC FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS

These scholarships have been created by individuals, service clubs, corporations, and foundations to provide financial assistance to the students of Alpena Community College. For your convenience, they are listed by course of study or other key categories.

A student who wishes to be considered for a specific scholarship must meet the qualifications and fill out the scholarship application form. An applicant must have a high school diploma or GED or demonstrate the ability to benefit from a particular program of study. Some scholarships require letters of recommendation and/or essays, and may be renewable for a second year provided all requirements are met.

Scholarship awards are applied to the student's account in equal amounts over the fall and spring semesters. If the scholarship recipient does not attend ACC for the fall semester, the scholarship award will be forfeited.

HOW TO APPLY FOR SCHOLARSHIPS

◆ Apply for admission to Alpena Community College by completing admission forms obtained from either the ACC Campus Services Office at Van Lare Hall or area high school counselors. Your application may also be completed online at www.alpenacc.edu. Click on "Future Students" and then "Apply."

◆ At the same time, apply for financial aid by completing financial aid forms available from the same sources as above.

Note: If applying for a scholarship where financial need must be demonstrated, results of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) must be received by Campus Services prior to the scholarship application deadline.

◆ Complete the ACC scholarship application form; include any required letters of recommendation and your high school or college transcript; indicate the scholarship(s) for which you are applying; and provide any other documentation required by the specific scholarship(s).

Please return a completed application form with appropriate attachments by March 30, 2012 to ACC CAMPUS SERVICES OFFICE, 665 Johnson Street, Alpena, MI 49707.

NOTE: Those scholarships denoted with an asterisk (*) are administered through the ACC Foundation, and those scholarships with an icon (📎) after their title require the submission of this application form plus additional information as indicated in the scholarship description.

TIPS FOR BECOMING A SUCCESSFUL SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT

1. Read the application carefully and follow the directions.
2. The scholarship application form is usually the first document reviewed by selection committees. If you have illegible or messy handwriting, consider typing the application.
3. Letters of recommendation may be required for some scholarships, and they are extremely important. Keep in mind that most individuals and instructors are quite busy and will need some time to develop a good letter of recommendation.
4. Take the initiative to find scholarship(s) that apply to you and be specific about which scholarships you are applying for. In the section "Name of scholarship(s) for which you are applying for," DO NOT write "all that apply." That's your job to indicate which scholarships you are interested in applying for.
5. Be sure to include all significant activities and honors received. Activities should represent varied talents and passions outside the classroom.
6. If essays are to be included, write clearly and follow the assigned topic. Also, applicants are encouraged to proofread and be sure to check spelling.
7. The last element in applying for a scholarship is getting it delivered on time. Before mailing, be sure to read through everything one more time to ensure that all of the necessary information is included.

ARTS

* JUDITH DONALD MEMORIAL FINE ARTS SCHOLARSHIP

This \$300 scholarship is awarded to a student enrolled in the Fine Arts program on a full- or part-time basis. Preference will be given to individuals facing health challenges and/or unusual circumstances and students who have received their GED.

* FINE ARTS, MUSIC & PERFORMING ARTS SCHOLARSHIP

These \$500 scholarships are awarded to students enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours of fine arts, music, or performing arts courses.

* AVIS HINKS MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP

This \$200 scholarship is awarded to a full- or part-time student who is enrolled in at least one music theory, jazz ensemble, or music-related course. A letter of recommendation from a former music director and a short essay describing what music means to you and your future plans in music are required.

CLEM MASON FINE ARTS — ALPENA LIONS CLUB MEMORIAL FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

This \$250 scholarship is awarded to a graduate of Alpena High School who is enrolled in one of the fine arts programs and has a minimum 2.0 GPA. This scholarship is renewable with a 2.0 GPA. *An Alpena Lions Club application must be submitted through your high school counselor.*

ATHLETICS

* ALPENA BOOSTERS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

These \$500 scholarships are awarded to a male and female athlete enrolled on a full- or part-time basis in a certificate or degree program. Applicants must be graduates of Alpena High School where they played a varsity sport, have a minimum 2.0 GPA, and demonstrate financial need. Alpena Boosters Club members and their families are excluded.

* STACY FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

These \$500 scholarships are awarded to students who are working toward an Associate in Applied Science Degree in Accounting or Business Management, or an Associate in Arts Degree with a concentration in Business Administration. Priority shall be given to candidates who intend to be involved in the College's athletic program as a student athlete while enrolled at ACC.

* WILK FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

These \$500 scholarships are awarded to students enrolled in an occupational program of two years or less and demonstrate financial need. Priority shall be given to candidates who intend to be involved in the College's athletic program as a student athlete while enrolled at ACC.

AUTOMOTIVE

* CLIFF ANSCHUETZ SCHOLARSHIP

This \$250 non-renewable award is for one year of study. Recipient must be an Alpena High School graduate accepted in the Automotive Service & Repair Program. Financial need and the academic capability to be successful in the program must be demonstrated. Recipient must maintain an overall 2.5 GPA throughout the scholarship year.

* RAMBLIN RODS CAR CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

One \$250 scholarship is awarded to a student from Northeast Michigan who has completed his or her first year of the Automotive Service & Repair Program. A second \$250 scholarship is awarded to a student from Northeast Michigan who is entering his or her second semester of the Auto Body Repair Program. The scholarship recipients must have a minimum 2.5 GPA.

BUSINESS

* EDWARD ADAMS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

These \$500 scholarships are awarded to students who have graduated from a Northeast Michigan high school and are interested in studying banking or finance. Scholarships are renewable if a 3.0 or higher GPA is maintained.

* BESSER COMPANY SCHOLARSHIP

These \$500 scholarships are awarded to full-time students who are pursuing a degree through the World Center for Concrete Technology, the Madeline Briggs University Center, or a university/college of their choice. Candidates must have a minimum 2.5 GPA. Preference will be given to students enrolled in the Concrete Technology, Nursing or a Business-related program, as well as employees of Besser Company or a concrete industry sponsor. A letter of recommendation is required.

* BONCZYK FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a full- or part-time student who is pursuing an Associate in Applied Science Degree in Business Management. Candidates must have a minimum 2.5 GPA and demonstrate financial need.

* ESI INDUSTRIAL SALES SCHOLARSHIP

These scholarships are awarded to students who are pursuing an Associates Degree in Industrial Sales, participating in an ESI-sponsored mentorship, and intending to achieve a career as an industrial sales professional. The scholarship amount is renewable and will range from \$125 to \$500 per semester based upon cumulative GPA. *Applicants must contact Brian VanWormer at (989) 358-7190 if interested.*

* DOREEN MCCLAY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

These \$1,000 scholarships are awarded to students who are pursuing a career in business administration or management program.

* ROBERT E. MUNROE SCHOLARSHIP FOR ENTREPRENEURIAL STUDY

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a full- or part-time student accepted into the Small Business Management Program. Interested applicants must submit an essay explaining their plans for the future and their interest in owning and operating a small business. A 3.0 GPA and one letter of reference is also required.

* CARL & HELEN PATZER SCHOLARSHIP

This \$200 scholarship is awarded to a student who is pursuing a career in business or the natural sciences (including ornithology or field biology). A GPA of 2.5 or higher is required and financial need will be considered. The scholarship may be used for tuition or toward a legitimate field project approved by an ACC instructor.

* STACY FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP — See "Athletics"

*** XLT CORP. SCHOLARSHIP** 📄

This \$250 scholarship is awarded to a part-time, non-traditional student in business or any technical program. An essay describing past education, work history and skills, community involvement, and plans for the future must be submitted, as well as a letter of recommendation supporting the student's education and career aspirations. Financial need is a factor, and a minimum 3.0 GPA is required.

COMPUTER-AIDED DRAFTING & DESIGN TECHNOLOGY

*** ALAN BEITLER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** 📄

This \$500 scholarship sponsored by Bay Mfg. Corp. is awarded to a student who is pursuing a certificate or degree program in Computer-Aided Drafting & Design Technology or Manufacturing Technology, or a career in CAD Technology or Engineering. Applicants must have a minimum 2.0 GPA and submit two letters of recommendation. School and community involvement will be considered.

*** KRIS DAVID DZIESINSKI MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** 📄

This \$200 scholarship is awarded to a freshman student who is pursuing a degree in Computer-Aided Drafting & Design Technology. Candidates must be a graduating senior from Alpena High School and have a minimum 3.0 GPA.

*** ESI DRAFTING/DESIGN SCHOLARSHIP** 📄

These scholarships are awarded to students who are pursuing degrees in Computer-Aided Drafting & Design Technology or pre-engineering, participating in an ESI-sponsored mentorship, and intending to achieve a career in CAD technology. These renewable scholarships will range from \$125 to \$500 per semester based upon cumulative GPA. *Applicants must contact Brian VanWormer at (989) 358-7190 if interested.*

*** MICHAEL GORDON GRAY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a student who is pursuing a degree in Engineering, Computer Science, or Computer Information Systems. Applicants must demonstrate financial need and have strong math and science skills.

CONCRETE TECHNOLOGY

*** BESSER COMPANY SCHOLARSHIP** 📄 — See "Business"

*** DALE T. & JUDITH L. DEAN SCHOLARSHIP**

These \$500 scholarships are awarded to freshman students entering the Concrete Technology Program who have an interest in a career in the masonry production industry. Full- or part-time students may apply. A minimum 2.0 GPA must be maintained.

*** JAMES A. DONAJKOWSKI MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a full-time student accepted into the Concrete Technology Program who demonstrates academic promise and dedication to the program.

*** ROBERT H. DOYLE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$250 scholarship is awarded to a freshman or sophomore student in Concrete Technology who demonstrates a commitment to the program and initiative in the classroom.

*** WILLIAM ELLER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$400 scholarship is awarded annually to a student demonstrating academic promise and dedication to the Concrete Technology Program.

*** DANNY E. ELLERY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to a full-time student who is enrolled in the Concrete Technology program and a dependent of a Consumers Concrete Corporation employee.

*** JOHN M. GRANT MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

These \$500 scholarships are awarded to students in the Concrete Technology Program who demonstrate financial need and reasonable academic performance. A minimum 3.0 GPA is recommended.

*** JAMIE M. KUCHNICKI MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a full-time student enrolled in the Concrete Technology program who demonstrates academic promise and dedication to the program.

L & S TRANSIT MIX SCHOLARSHIP

These \$250 scholarships are awarded annually to a freshman and sophomore Concrete Technology student based on academic merit and financial need.

*** LAFARGE CEMENT — ALPENA PLANT CONCRETE TECHNOLOGY SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$2,500 renewable scholarship is awarded to a full-time student from Northeast Michigan accepted into the Concrete Technology Program. Recipient must maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA.

WILLIS & EVA LANCASTER SCHOLARSHIP

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a sophomore Concrete Technology student based on academic merit and financial need.

ROBERT H. PAQUETTE SCHOLARSHIP

This \$500 non-renewable scholarship is awarded to a graduating senior at Alpena High School entering the Concrete Technology program as a full-time freshman. Recipient must demonstrate financial need. Preference is given to those with a 3.0 GPA or higher.

*** JAMES E. POTVIN SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to a student from Michigan accepted into the Concrete Technology Program. Preference will be given to applicants from the Cadillac area. Candidates must demonstrate financial need and have a minimum 2.5 GPA.

CRIMINAL JUSTICE/LAW ENFORCEMENT

*** SHERIFF DUANE A. BADDER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$200 scholarship is awarded to an active law enforcement officer or second-year law enforcement student. Priority is given to residents or employees of Presque Isle County. The award could go to a part-time student if he or she is currently a law enforcement officer. A minimum 2.0 GPA is required.

*** GERALD L. CARPENTER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a graduate of Alpena High School who is majoring in law enforcement or criminal justice. Candidate must have a minimum 2.5 GPA. This scholarship is renewable if recipient maintains at least a 2.5 GPA. Financial need is not a factor.

*** BRYON S. EGELSKI MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** 📄

These \$500 scholarships are awarded to sophomores majoring in criminal justice and have graduated from a high school in Alcona, Alpena, Iosco, Montmorency, or Presque Isle County. Candidates must possess a minimum overall 2.0 GPA and maintain a minimum overall 2.5 GPA throughout the scholarship year. A letter indicating why you chose criminal justice is also required.

*** TROOPER LARRY FORREIDER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a sophomore student who has successfully completed his/her freshman year at ACC, is majoring in law enforcement, and has graduated from a school in Alcona, Alpena, Montmorency, or Presque Isle County. Applicants must demonstrate good citizenship, public service, and moral integrity.

WILLIAM F. KELLER F.O.P. SCHOLARSHIP

These \$350 scholarships are awarded to students who are beginning their sophomore year in the ACC law enforcement program and who reside in Alpena, Alcona, Presque Isle or Montmorency County. Candidates must have a minimum 2.0 GPA and have an expressed interest in becoming a police officer. Financial need is not a factor.

*** HAGOP "JAKE" KUREDJIAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

These \$500 scholarships are awarded to full-time students from Michigan who are pursuing an associate's degree in criminal justice or law enforcement. Candidates must have a minimum 2.75 GPA and demonstrate good citizenship and moral integrity.

*** ROBERT L. SCHULKE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

These \$500 scholarships are awarded to students who are cancer survivors or have an immediate family member that is a cancer survivor, or has passed away due to cancer. Special consideration will be given to those students enrolled in a health occupations or law enforcement program. Candidates must be a resident of Alpena County, enrolled at ACC for a minimum of six credit hours per semester, and maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA.

*** DEPUTY RYAN SEGUIN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** 📄

These \$500 scholarships are awarded to sophomore students pursuing a degree in criminal justice or law enforcement. Candidates must have a minimum 2.0 GPA and live in Alpena, Alcona, Montmorency, Presque Isle or Iosco Counties. An essay is required describing why the candidate feels he/she is deserving of this scholarship. A personal interview will also be conducted by the donors. Preference will be given to applicants from Alpena County.

*** GARY TOMASZEWSKI—ALPENIA AREA F.O.P. SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$350 scholarship is awarded to a student from Northeast Michigan who is pursuing a certificate or degree in criminal justice or law enforcement. Applicants must possess a minimum 2.5 GPA and demonstrate good citizenship.

EDUCATION

*** HELEN B. BASEL SCHOLARSHIP**

These \$750 scholarships are awarded to students enrolled in the education or health sciences field. Applicants must be graduates of Hillman High School and have at least a 3.0 GPA. Extra-curricular activities and community service will be considered.

*** MADELINE BRIGGS EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP** 📄

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a student pursuing a degree in education. An essay and letters of reference are required. Financial need and other hardships will be considered.

*** JAMES & LOIS BURCH HEALTH OCCUPATIONS & EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP** 📄

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a student in an education or health occupation degree program. The student must have a minimum 3.0 GPA in previous course work and must submit a letter of reference. Full- or part-time students may apply. This award is renewable if a 3.0 GPA is maintained.

*** CAMP MERRIMENT SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a full- or part-time student who is pursuing a career in special education and has a minimum 3.0 GPA.

*** MARIE CROSS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$100 scholarship is awarded to a full- or part-time student from Montmorency County who is pursuing a career in education.

*** O. B. & EVELYN EUSTIS ENVIRONMENTAL SCHOLARSHIP**

These \$500 scholarships are awarded to students pursuing a career in environmental science or education and have demonstrated active involvement in environmental activities. The award may be used for tuition or towards an environmental project approved by an ACC instructor. The scholarship is intended for persons who serve to protect, improve, or increase appreciation for our natural environment or for use in projects or causes which do so.

*** RICHARD H. & CAROL G. FERGUSON SCHOLARSHIP FUND FOR LEADERSHIP IN TEACHING**

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to an incoming freshman student who plans to major in elementary or secondary teacher education. Applicants must hold a minimum 3.0 GPA, have financial need, and demonstrate involvement in school and community leadership activities. First preference will be given to elementary music and English majors and then to former Alpena Public School students.

*** ERNESTINE M. JASKEY TEACHER'S SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$250 scholarship is awarded to a full- or part-time student enrolled in a certificate or degree program who is pursuing a career in education. A minimum 3.0 GPA is required.

*** ROBERT W. & ILA C. JONES EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP**

These \$500 scholarships are awarded to students majoring in education. Awards are based on academic merit and financial need.

*** JEAN MARTINDALE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$250 scholarship is awarded to a resident of Alpena County who is pursuing a career in elementary education.

*** DEE NEWPORT FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a student who is pursuing a degree in education with plans to become an elementary school teacher. Preference will be given to students participating in ACC athletics.

*** MARIETTA BOLDREY PEWOSKI SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$300 scholarship is awarded to a part- or full-time student who is a graduating senior from Hillman High School and pursuing a degree in education. Extra-curricular activities and community service will be considered.

ENGINEERING

*** ACC ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIP**

Up to \$1,250 is awarded to a student who is pursuing a degree in engineering or a related field and has demonstrated high academic potential as a dual-enrolled student.

*** FRANK AGIUS FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to a student who attended Alpena High School for four years, graduated from AHS, and is enrolled full time in ACC's pre-engineering program. Candidates must also have a minimum 3.0 GPA.

*** MICHAEL GORDON GRAY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

— See "Computer-Aided Drafting & Design Technology"

*** RAY H. HERNER SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$400 scholarship is awarded to a full- or part-time student from Northeast Michigan who is enrolled in ACC's pre-engineering program and plans to transfer into an engineering program at a four-year university. Financial need is a factor, and the recipient is required to maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA. The scholarship will be renewable if the recipient achieves a 3.0 GPA or better.

*** GEORGE C. KISTLER SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$250 scholarship is awarded to a sophomore pre-engineering student who demonstrates a commitment to continuing education and academic excellence. Candidates must have a minimum 3.0 GPA and plan to transfer into an engineering program at a four-year college or university.

*** CHRISTOPHER & JULIE McCOY ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a student who is a graduating high school senior who plans to transfer into an engineering program at a four-year university. Applicants must demonstrate financial need and have a minimum 3.0 GPA. This scholarship is renewable if the recipient maintains a 3.0 GPA.

*** PEER ACADEMIC LEADER SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a traditional full-time student who is enrolled in ACC's pre-engineering program, demonstrates a commitment to academic excellence, and plans to transfer into an engineering program at a four-year university. Candidates must have a minimum 3.0 GPA and demonstrate good citizenship and leadership ability. Special consideration will be given to those who wish to pursue a career in biomedical engineering.

*** HELEN B. BASEL SCHOLARSHIP** — See "Education"

*** JAMES & LOIS BURCH HEALTH OCCUPATIONS & EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP**  — See "Education"

*** DAWN MARIE BURNS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

These \$500 scholarships are awarded to students who are cancer survivors or have an immediate family member who is a cancer survivor, or has passed away from cancer. Recipients must be enrolled at ACC for a minimum of 6 credit hours per semester and maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA. Special consideration will be given to those students in the health occupations field.

*** NANCY & MIKE DESROCHER NURSING SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to an ACC second-year nursing student who has demonstrated a genuine caring personality as judged by his or her nursing instructors and is deemed a dedicated student with an above-average work ethic. GPA is not a consideration.

*** DR. KATHRYN A. HOPPE SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$300 scholarship is awarded to a full-time student who plans to earn a degree and pursue a career as a dentist or medical doctor. Applicants must be a graduate of Alpena High School and have a minimum 3.0 GPA.

*** FREDERICK I. & BETTE ANNE EGGAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$250 scholarship is awarded to a Level II Associate Degree nursing student with a GPA of 3.0 or higher. Recipient must be a resident of Alcona, Alpena, Montmorency, or Presque Isle County. Academic performance and financial need are considered, with preference given to any student who meets all criteria and has an expressed interest in oncology nursing.

*** BARBARA JACQUEMIN, BSN, RN SCHOLARSHIP**

These scholarship award amounts vary (\$250-\$500). Applicants must be full-time students enrolled in ACC's Nursing Program who have successfully completed the Level I program and are entering the Level II program. The following will be considered when making the award determination: the student communicates well and teaches patients at the bedside; displays eagerness to perform every patient-care procedure; is enthusiastic and demonstrates a positive, caring attitude; is prepared with information needed to carry out the tasks to complete each shift; and helps and supports nursing classmates.

*** KANE THUNDER BAY COMMUNITY HEALTH SERVICES CHRISTMAS SCHOLARSHIP** 

This \$250 scholarship is awarded to a student who is pursuing a degree in nursing or as a medical assistant. Candidates must reside in Alpena, Montmorency or Presque Isle County, have a minimum 3.0 GPA, and demonstrate financial need. Three letters of recommendation must be submitted.

*** THOMAS A. & AMY L. KANE NURSING SCHOLARSHIP** 

This \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to a student who is accepted into ACC's Level II nursing program. Candidates must reside in Alpena, Montmorency or Presque Isle County, have a minimum 3.0 GPA, and demonstrate financial need. Three letters of recommendation must be submitted.

*** EVELYN LAFAVE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a single mother who is enrolled in ACC's Nursing LPN program (Level I). Students must demonstrate financial need and have a minimum 3.5 GPA.

*** PATRICIA PIPER SCHOLARSHIP**

These \$500 awards are awarded to a Northeast Michigan resident enrolled on a full- or part-time basis in any degree or certificate program. The scholarship may be renewed for a second year if the recipient maintains a minimum 2.0 GPA.

*** PRESIDENTIAL LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP**

These \$600 scholarships are awarded to students with leadership potential who are chosen through recommendations by high school counselors and principals. Academic achievement, as well as high school and community involvement will be considered.

*** SUE E. SANDY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$250 scholarship is awarded to a full- or part-time student who is enrolled in an associate degree or certificate program. Candidates must demonstrate financial need and academic promise.

*** JILLIAN PAIGE SEGUIN SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$250 scholarship is awarded to a sophomore student enrolled full-time with a minimum 3.5 GPA, and who demonstrates community service and/or volunteer work as well as on-campus involvement.

EMERY H. TIMM SCHOLARSHIP

This \$300 renewable scholarship is awarded to a student enrolled in a construction-related program. Priority is given to sons or daughters of Northeastern Michigan Home Builders Association members.

JERRY & JACKIE TIMM SCHOLARSHIP

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a first-generation college student who is pursuing a degree or certificate in any ACC program. Financial need is a factor.

*** RICHARD S. WERTZ MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

This \$400 scholarship is awarded to a student from Northeast Michigan who is enrolled on a full- or part-time basis. The recipient must work on the College newspaper, *CrossCut*, and plan to pursue a journalism degree upon graduation from ACC.

This \$150 scholarship is awarded to a resident of Long Rapids Township who demonstrates high academic capability, excellent citizenship and character, and financial need.
